Morro Bay SP Car-Camp Friday-Monday, May 26-29, 2006

COST: \$13.00 per person + \$10.00 per car

TRIP LIMIT: 24 people, 2 cars per site (3 sites)

DESCRIPTION: Morro Bay State Park features lagoon and natural bay habitat. The bay's most prominent landmark is Morro Rock. The park has opportunities for sailing, fishing, hiking, and bird watching. The park museum has exhibits covering natural features and cultural history, Native American life, geology, and oceanography. The park also has a colorful marina and an 18-hole public golf course. On the bay's northeast edge is a pristine saltwater marsh that supports a thriving bird population.

CAMPGROUND: They are only able to accommodate TWO vehicles per campsite - developed and hookups. This includes trailers and other towed vehicles. Fees include entry for 1 vehicle and 1 legally towed vehicle or trailer. Additional vehicles will be charged per night at the park.

We have 3 sites reserved. Check in time is 2:00 pm Friday, May 26th and check out time is 12:00 pm Monday, May 29th.

BRING: Normal car-camping gear: tent, sleeping bag, food, flashlight, etc.

PRETRIP DISCUSSION: Will be held on Tuesday, May 23rd from noon to 1 pm in room 125-16A. Be there or be represented. Reservation priority is based upon when the reservation form (see below) is received by the trip leader along with a payment check. Happy hour plans will also be discussed at this session.
