California Trail Days April 22

April 1: With the Mt Lowe East Trail and Muir Peak Trails completed, we will start maintenance on Mt Lowe West and San Gabriel Peak depending upon the weather, and road access.

April 22: The USDA Forest Service and associated LARRD volunteer organizations will celebrate California Trails Day. The celebration will include 4-6 hours of trail work on the Millard area trails and a barbecue lunch at Millard. This event is organized by the volunteer groups of the Los Angeles River Ranger District. Lunch will be held at Millard Campground and will include a short ceremony about California Trails Day. Lunch will be served at 1:00 PM. Activities will end at 3:30 PM. This activity is open to all volunteers, including sponsored groups. Those who are volunteering for trail work for the first time, please identify yourself to the registrar, so we can arrange for a Trail Boss to provide instruction and proper tools. Please bring personal equipment listed below.

BRING: Work Gloves, Work Shoes, Work Clothes (long sleeve shirts and long pants), sun protection hat, hard-hat (if available), Water (2 Qt's.), snacks. April 1 also bring lunch. April 22: Be prepared to hike about a mile and work until 12:30, lunch will be provided at Millard Campground.

MEET:

April 1: Meet at 8:15 AM at ball diamonds parking lot in the lower part of Hahamonga Park. Get off the 210 freeway at the Berkshire off-ramp and follow the signs for JPL and Hahamonga Park. Once you turn into the park, go down the driveway, make a right at the bottom and look for us in the parking lot by the ball diamonds. . We will sign in and form carpools, leaving at 8:30 sharp, returning around 4 PM. The leaders always take passengers, but make sure you have plenty of gas in case we need more drivers (riders can give drivers \$1 towards gas). If you need to leave early, notify the leaders at sign-in time.

April 22: Meet at 8:00 a.m., registration: 8:00 to 8:30 am at the Millard Campground Parking Lot. From 210 Fwy in La Canada, exit at Windsor/Arroyo Blvd, turn north and go to Woodbury Avenue. Turn right (east) onto Woodbury and proceed to Lincoln Avenue (1 mile), turn left (north) onto Lincoln and proceed to Loma Alta Drive (6 blocks). Turn right (east) onto Loma Alta Drive and turn left (north) onto Chaney Trail (flashing yellow light). Take Chaney Trail to the crest of the hill and go down (left) to Millard Campground. Allow 20 minutes Driving Time from the 210 Fwy. JPL Trailbuilders can meet at April 1 carpool place at 7:45. Call Kathie to expect you there.
