DESCRIPTION: WHAT HAPPENED:

One of our scheduled days, we continued maintenance on Mt Lowe East Trail from Eaton Saddle, mostly cutting back brush.

Another day we worked the Mt Hillyer Trail for the upcoming Angeles Crest 100-mile race. We worked to make the tread more even, widened the brushing, and made the trail more obvious in places with logs and large rocks.

WHAT'S HAPPENING:

In this hotter weather, we will work the shady parts of Mt Lowe East and West Trails. Maintenance consists mainly of lopping brush and widening trail tread.

BRING: Dayhike gear (daypack, lunch, lots of water), sun screen, bug repellent, hat, sturdy shoes, and work gloves. You can bring your own tools or are welcome to use those from our group supply.

MEET- Meet at 8:15 AM at ball diamonds parking lot in the lower part of Hahamongna Park. Get off the 210 freeway at the Berkshire off-ramp and follow the signs for JPL and Hahamongna Park. Once you turn into the park, go down the driveway to the left, make a right at the bottom and look for us in the parking lot by the ball diamonds. (If that is full, we park in the dirt lot directly at the bottom of the driveway) We will sign in and form carpools, leaving at 8:30 sharp, returning around 4 PM. The leaders always take passengers, but make sure you have plenty of gas in case we need more drivers (riders can give drivers \$1 towards gas). If you need to leave early, notify the leaders at sign-in time.
