## Mt. Wilson Loop

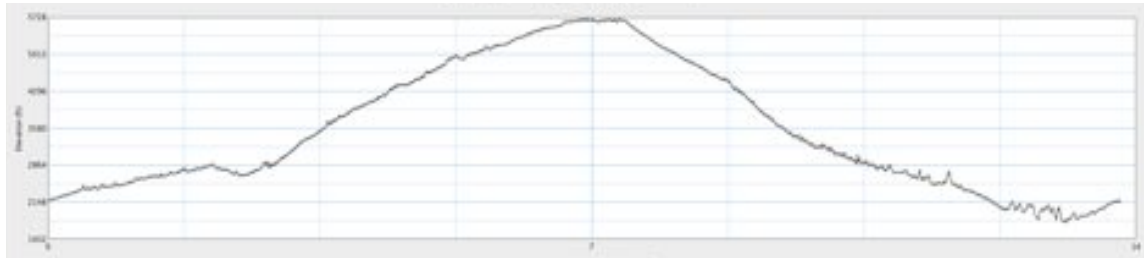
**CLASSIFICATION:** Strenuous    **COST:** None    **TRIP LIMIT:** None



**DESCRIPTION:** We will hike from Chantry Flat to Mount Wilson on the Winter Creek Trail and return on the Sturtevant Trail. This hike is 13¼ miles long, going from 2150 ft elevation to 5728 ft. It should take about 6½ hours.

Those interested in a late lunch will gather at Red Lobster, 928 W. Huntington in Monrovia following the hike.

**BRING:** Good shoes, plenty of liquid, snacks.



**MEET:** We can meet at JPL and car pool or meet in the upper Chantry Flat parking lot.

***Please send an e-mail to the trip leader letting him know of your interest in this hike and with your preference for car pooling or meeting at Chantry Flat.***

To get to Chantry Flat, take the 210 Freeway (East of Pasadena). Exit Santa Anita Avenue and go North (toward the mountains). Go to the end of the road and park in one of the parking lots. A National Forest Adventure Pass is required to park at Chantry Flat – the trip leader has 2 passes.
